Role of Training and Placement in the Institution

In addition Training and placement of SCE, to attain the above stated goal, the following key plans of action have been framed

- To organize mock Group discussion sessions, mock technical interviews and also Mock Tests to improve their communications skills & interview facing skills to meet specific hiring Company needs.
- To strengthen the coding skills of the students and encourage them to crack various hackathon contests including InfyTQ, HackWithInfy, and TCS CodeVita.
- To arrange Campus Recruitment drives (they could be exclusive in-campus drives, or off-campus pooled drives).
- To encourage students to undergo internship programs in their final year of study so that they get familiar with the industry workflow well before the actual on-boarding on to the job.

IMPLEMENTATION AND OUTCOMES

Implementation

We provide the following training process. A constant review and adapt methodology is followed to help us update the system and reach the aforesaid goals and objectives:

• An internal Aptitude, Reasoning, and Verbal (ARV) training right from III semester and periodical assessments for the same to evaluate students' performance.









- As part of the regular academics an internal coding training by the faculty of CSE and IT, right from V semester. Since the industry perception is that the screening process of Infosys is about the most thorough one, our training adheres to the syllabus prescribed by Infosys for the InfyTQ certification.
- An outsourced 8-day ARV training in the beginning of VII semester.
- An outsourced 5-day training on Vedic Maths in the beginning of III semester.
- Student Development Programs(SDPs) through mock face-to-face interviews. SDPs help students acquire knowledge on resume writing, self-introduction, interview presentation skills etc. The SDPs help the students to identify areas they need to improve upon and also areas of strength that they need to build and enhance.
- Special Internal Technical trainings for helping students get through Hackathon like contests. (InfyTQ/HackWithInfy/TCS CodeVita)
- Subscribing to Interview Question Bank Portals and providing access to the students. This provides the students access to hundreds of company specific online tests(both IT and Core companies).
- 10-day Infosys intensive training to capitalise on our Day-1 placement status that Infosys has accorded the Institution..
- Acknowledging the good and hard work put in by the placed students by hosting get-togethers to honor them. In these get-togethers we motivate the placed students to help and energize the unplaced students.
- Encouraging students to apply for internship program using forums like Internshala.
- Arranging motivational talks by experts/alumni to guide students and prepare them to appear in competitive exams like GATE.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BY AND BETWEEN

1. Scope:

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into by and between Six Phrase, a Soft skills and Industry Skills Training & Development Academy, with its principal address at 93-A, GKD Nagar, PN Palayam, Coimbatore – 641 037 (hereinafter called as Six Phrase) and Saranathan College of Engineering, Trichy. (hereinafter called as Saranathan)

WHEREAS, this MOU is agreed between Six Phrase and Saranathan, for the Training and Development activities for the engineering batch of 2016-2020 graduating in 2020 in the areas of skill development as agreed in the proposal / statement of work.

2. Statement of work:

Six Phrase agrees to provide the services as described in the Proposal documents with the abstract as below;

3. Executive Summary:

4. Term of the MOU:

The term of this MOU shall commence on 21-May-2019, and end by 20-May-2020, or until the MOU is terminated pursuant to the terms contained herein, whichever event occurs first.

5. Responsibilities:

Six Phrase agrees to:

- 1. Offer the training programs and competency development programs as prescribed in the proposals
- 2. Offer and execute the value additions / Benefits as stated in the Executive summary.
- 3. Supply the student with course training and evaluation materials.
- 4. Maintain student records on individuals for a minimum of 2 years or 1 year after the life of the MOU, whichever is greater. As a minimum, these records should contain the following: course title, hours of instruction, location, and dates; instructor(s) name(s), level of instructor certification, trainee details, progress & evaluation.
- 5. Change/modify the training time/duration to accommodate any changes in academic/college functions, with appropriate written (email) notice of 2 working days in advance in general and in special cases to a mutually agreeable shorter notice.
- 6. That in case an emergency change is made without prior notice, the right of suspension/re-plan for the cancelled session is at the discretion of Six Phrase and the availability of resources.
- 7. Provide the college a written notification of course dates, time schedule, location, and lead instructor for all courses. Such notification shall be provided at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the course starting date. When courses must be scheduled to meet emergency training needs, representatives from college and Six Phrase may waive this seven (7) day notification. Requests for waiver may be made by email.
- 8. Verify instructor records to ensure that instructors meet or exceed standard qualifications.
- 9. Assure assessments Communication & Soft skills are administered properly and reported to the management for discussion.
- 10. To provide Saranathan with a relationship Officer/manager to handle the issues/escalations/discussions.
- 11. Any change in program/adjustment of Classroom sessions provided they will be intimated to both the parties (Six Phrase & Saranathan), at appropriate notice in advance.
- 12. The college providing classroom for all the sessions.
- 13. Notifying well in advance any requirement of Seminar Halls with projector facility for delivering appropriate content for Soft skills/Industry interface/Guest lectures, preferably at the time of signing the MoU.
- 14. Saranathan mentioning/using Six Phrase's name/Logo/Brand as their Training partner in brochures/Bill boards /hoardings/Advertisements/Website.
- 15. Six Phrase using Saranathan's Brand/Logo in their client List.

- 16. Drafting separately as warranted a Statement of Work/Proposal for any other associative program envisaged.
- 17. Providing an option that the contract be renewed every year, upon Mutual Consent after completion of one year and regularised by a new agreement/MOU with satisfactory development in the students' skills, as assessed by a common methodology.
- 18. Assisting Saranathan by arranging between 5(five) and 8(eight) placement drives in multi discipline sectors.

6. Execution:

- The total training is for 8 days. 6 days out of those 8 days being conducted now between 20th and 26th June (both days inclusive, excluding 23rd June). The balance two days would be used up as 2 x 1 day special corporate specific training later based on mutually agreed dates.
- 2. A typical training day will consist of training from morning 9:15 am to 4:45 pm with a lunch break and two intervals in the FN and AN.
- It has been agreed that you will offer an on line test to all students in the week prior to the beginning of training. This is scheduled to be held on 12th June 2019.
- 4. Based on the scores of this test the students would be classified into 4 groups Alpha, Beta, Gamma & Theta.
- 5. This classification, contents and materials, must be ready and available with us before the training starts.
- The course content, delivery and methodology for each of these groups would be different.
- 7. All tests are to be conducted Online- Six Phrase will provide question patterns to be installed in Client location (Saranathan) enabling the students to take online tests for assessments.
- 8. Logistics -Accommodation / Transportation of the trainers to be taken care of by Six Phrase.
- Tea/Coffee, snacks and lunch will be provided free at the campus on the days of training.
- 10. At the time of signing the MoU Six Phrase to provide Master Plan/Execution Plan (Details of the program).
- 11. To facilitate and supervise the smooth and hassle free delivery of the program both the parties will intimate each other the name of the Single Point of Contact

(SPoC). Any deviation from the agreed program will have to be based on discussion and mutual agreement between the SPoCs.

- 12. The batch strength agreed to is 30 students. Minor variations to this number would be accepted but in no case should the strength exceed 35. Any other change in class strength has to be based on discussion and mutual agreement between the two SPoCs.
- 13. For Billing purposes, if the class attendance is less than 30 and classes cannot be clubbed/combined, an average count of 30 will be taken for billing.
- 14. At the time of signing the MoU, Six Phrase will submit a list of trainers, their resumes highlighting their experience in this field. The trainers are expected to have very high communication skills.
- 15. Based on feedback Six Phrase should be capable of replacing a trainer or trainers from one day to the other.
- 16. Attendance taking is compulsory for every session. A session is defined as that period between two breaks. The attendance details should be available within the first 15 minutes of the session.
- 17. The number of students for invoicing will be the average number of students who attended the total session. The average will be calculated based on the attendance of every day. This will be compiled and communicated to the vendor.
- 18. There is no minimum billing figure agreed upon.
- 19. On the last day of the program there would be a post training on-line test to measure the effectiveness of the program.
- 20. We will use the services of another independent vendor for providing us a parallel set of post training on-line test scores. The average scores of the two tests (yours and the 3rd parties) would be used to determine the effectiveness of the course.
- 21. On the last day all students who have more than 75% attendance in the training program should be given a Certificate of Participation.

7. Compensation

- In consideration of the services (Training and Development) promises and performance of Six Phrase, Saranathan agrees to pay as detailed in the Proposal, upon actual receipt of proper invoices, including time sheets, compensation upon the completion of each deliverable as specified in proposal.
- 2. Saranathan agrees to pay in full (less applicable TDS) within 29 days of receipt of invoice for the service rendered by Six Phrase and agrees to compensate Six Phrase on prevailing Interest rate (Bank rate) for any delay in payment.
- 3. The payment would be staggered -

20% against order on the 1st day of the course,

10% against submission of pre and post course results (5% each),

50% on completion of the course,

15% against completion of the committed drives (3% per drive subject to a maximum of 15%),

the balance 5% against pre-agreed conversion rates in the aptitude tests of Infosys and one another MNC organised under Anna University/ or elsewhere.

The individual amounts would be paid as partial payments and when effecting the final payment the figures will be tallied and the account settled.

- 4. We have agreed on a tested to cleared conversion of 40 % and above.
- 5. The amount agreed is Rs 2000/ student for the total 8 day program.
- 6. The rate is inclusive of applicable taxes if any.
- 7. The rate is inclusive of handouts and materials (printed or otherwise) that would be required for the proper delivery of the training program.

8. Infrastructure

Saranathan College of Engineering will provide the infrastructures of class rooms, auditoriums, access to playgrounds, projectors and computers as and when required for the training purposes.

9. Rights in data, patents and copyright

Six Phrase reserves all rights and authority for the contents, presentations, materials, preparatory materials, training documents shared/provided during the training programme. Any documents mentioned should not be shared/used/copied/modified for other purposes/ with other parties/ other departments without the written consent from Six Phrase.

10. Amendments or Modification

No amendment or modification to this MOU shall be effective against either party unless such an amendment or modification is set forth in writing and signed by both parties.

This Memorandum Of Understanding is made on 10.11.2011 at Trichy by and between

ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu, acting by and through its Chief Executive Officer as the authorized officer of the ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu having their office at ELCOT Complex, 2-7, Developed Plots, Industrial Estate, Perungudi, Chennai – 600 096 (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns, nominee/s and or delegate/s) (hereinafter referred to as the "ICTACT") on one part

AND

Saranathan College of Engineering having its office Venkateswara Nagar, Panjappur at Trichy and represented by its Principal as second part, hereinafter mentioned as Saranathan Engineering on the other part.

The above are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party").

WITNESSETH:

ICTACT is a society formed by a consortium of Government of India, Government of Tamil Nadu and Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) with the mandate on improving the quality of students passing out of educational institutions in Tamil Nadu. The focal point is to make them industry ready and immediately employable in ICT industry.

ICTACT proposes to launch the Skill Development Centers across the State of Tamil Nadu, under a proprietary identity "SKILLEDGE" in the higher education institutions.

The objective of launching the skill development centers is to empower the students by providing industry relevant skills thereby making them industry-ready.

NOW THEREFORE it is mutually agreed by and between the Parties as under

1. ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

ICTACT shall define the roles and responsibilities for the smooth implementation of the project from time to time based on mutually acceptable terms.

2. TERM AND TERMINATION:

It is agreed that the parties shall jointly explore and work together from the effective date hereof to give effect to the intent and purpose of this Agreement. Termination of the agreement would be mutually agreed in writing by the parties hereto but it can be done only at the end of the academic year.

3. GOVERNING LAW:

This agreement and all questions of its interpretation shall be construed in accordance with the laws of India under the jurisdiction of the courts in Chennai.

4. NOTICES AND COMMUNICATIONS:

Any notice or other information required or authorized by this agreement to be given shall be given in writing, in English and by hand delivery with a written acknowledgement in receipt thereof or sending it by registered post with acknowledgement due, by courier with proof of delivery or sending it by facsimile transmission or e-mail communication.

PARTIAL INVALIDITY:

Any infirmity nor invalidity of any part of this agreement shall not ipso factum invalidate this agreement and this agreement is valid in other aspects and the invalidity can be substituted by suitable modification and or by new terms.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY:

This agreement and all written or electronic information (including oral discussions thereafter reduced to writing or otherwise recorded) in connection with the efforts contemplated in this agreement shall be treated as confidential, and may not be used by any party except in connection with the subject matter of this agreement, or disclosed to any other person (other than its affiliates, employees, consultants and advisors, who shall be bound to a similar degree of confidentiality, and limited to such extent that are required to perform their official functions) without the prior written consent of the other party. Confidential information shall not include information which now or hereafter enters the public domain through no violation of this clause. Neither party shall issue a press statement or disclose the contents hereof or matters related thereto to the press or any third party except with the express and prior written approval of the other.

NON-TRANSFERABILITY:

This agreement duly executed is not transferable in case of any merger/acquisition with or by other institutions.

8. AMENDMENT:

Any modification, amendment, or waiver of any provision of this agreement shall be effective if, but only if, in writing and signed in person or by an authorised representative of each party.

9. COMMERCIAL

ICTACT shall provide the training to the teachers on industry relevant skill development courses. ICTACT shall provide the required content such as pedagogical tools, teaching materials, learning materials, work book and model questions for the students. All the above will be given free of cost to Saranathan College of Engineering. However assessment fees would be charged to the students. Saranathan College of Engineering shall collect the same and remit to ICTACT before the start of the course to the students. The fees shall be fixed by ICTACT after due consultations with Saranathan College of Engineering.

10. MEMBERSHIP & VALIDITY

The Institution hereby agrees to become Associate Member by paying the requisite Membership Fees to ICTACT. This Membership fee of Rs220600(Including service tax of20600) is non-transferable and non-refundable.

This MoU is valid for a period of Five Years from the date of signing this MoU.

11. PLACEMENT SUPPORT

ICTACT would provide three placement support opportunities to the students who have successfully completed the academic requirements and Skilledge requirements. This placement support activity will be conducted region wise as an off-campus program.


