Today, the twenty fourth annual day of our college is a significant day for all of us gathered here. The success story of our institution makes us remember the two important personalities — our founder secretary Vidya Seva Ratnam, Guru Seva Mani Auditor K Santhanam and our Bhishmacharya late director Prof. V. Nagarajan who led the path in which we are successfully marching towards the Silver Jubilee. Experiencing the showers of their blessings, our respect and gratitude will be for them ever and ever. Both of them were instrumental in setting our organisational bench mark very high so that this institution can take pride in being the most sought after college in the region.

I take great pride & pleasure in presenting the Annual report for the year 2021-22 of our prestigious institution.

One of the most significant achievements is that SIX UG branches (which include CSE, ECE, EEE, ICE, IT and MECHANICAL) of this institution have been further accredited by NBA for three more years.

My joy knows no bounds to share another noteworthy accomplishment in that the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has declared on April 19th 2021 that our institution is rated A+ grade with a CGPA of 3.27 out of 4.00.

As jewels in our crown, two more UG programmes namely B.Tech Artificial Intelligence and Data Sciences, B.Tech Computer Science and Business Systems have been introduced with an intake of 60 each.

I would be failing in my duty if I do not register here my sincerest thanks to the entire team of faculty (both teaching and non-teaching) for their display of total team work, dedication and the exemplary manner in which even the minutest details were addressed which made the institution achieve the significant milestones all within a year.

Infrastructure / Development:

- Bi-decennial block at an estimate of Rs.4.6 crores is ready for occupation.
- We have upgraded the centralised Computer Facility for hardware, software and computer peripherals with the total cost of Rs. 44, 67,236.
- A total of 556 books have been added to our Library collection this year bringing to a total of 57, 341 books.

Admissions:

- Thanks to the brand image the college has created and sustained and the continued confidence that the parents and students have reposed on our institution, we have been able to meet admission requirements this year also with enviable ease. It would not be out of place to mention here that the permission for introduction of new courses was possible because of our track record of enviable admission figures.
- As on date, we have 2441 students on rolls 1555 boys and 886 girls.

Academic performance of the students:

- I am very pleased to register at this juncture that the college proves to produce outstanding results in the Anna University examinations this academic year also.
- I am very proud to announce that from the 2021 batch of B.E., B.Tech., M.E., MBA, 659 students have successfully completed their course.

 64 of them have passed with distinction and 594 have passed with 1st class.

This facet is amply proved by the fact that 12 (Twelve) faculty members have successfully completed their doctoral degree. faculty members have published nearly 269articles in reputed Journals, National and International conferences. Nine research scholars have successfully completed their Ph.D program in our research centres, recognized by Anna University, Chennai. Besides these our staff members have published 34 patents, got 30 design patents, three utility patents.

Research and Development:

As a fitting reward to the sustained efforts by our faculty members to get consultancy projects and research projects with funding, we have had quite a few successes this year also.

PLACEMENT:

- We have an impeccable campus placement record during this academic year 2021-22. The most important companies in which our students have offers include Infosys Ltd, Tech Mahindra, TCS, CTS, MRF, E-Con Systems, Zoho, WIPRO etc. I am very proud to record here that this year was the 18th consecutive year for Infosys as our Day-1 hirer
- For the 1st time in the history of Saranathan, we have achieved a feat of securing 625 offers for the 2022 batch
- Out of 625 offers, 425 are from reputed MNC's especially from Infosys, CTS,
 TCS & Wipro
- The highest Cost to Company (CTC) package offered is Rs.11 Laks per annum. The average CTC on campus is Rs.3.75 Laks per annum.
- More than 50 organizations have recruited our students, and more than 150+ students are having multiple offers
- We have provided 35% of placements in core companies
- We have also started our placements for the 2023 batch students with 3 reputed organizations, e-Con, Vuram and Zoho Corporation who have recruited the students with a average package of 5.5 LPA
- Under AICTE Internships (through Internshala) our institute has secured 181st rank among 1100+ institutes (Nation-wide) for the academic year 2021, 67th Rank out of 488 participating colleges across the South Zone with around 200 internships offers and 25 plus internships with Pre-placement Offer.

Training:

Aiming to prepare the students to be industry ready to face the real-life corporate
world, we are arranging many workshops, webinars with the resource persons
from the corporate world to share their experience with our students and their
view points on the various cutting edge technologies.

- Our Training and Placement department has achieved the record in placing the students by providing quality training by professional external trainers for both Aptitude and Technical training for more than 150 hours
- Students are also provided with an online practice portal, Neopat which consists of 10,000+ tests including with company specific approach/ lecture videos/puzzles and quiz series which enabled our students to sharpen their skills
- Online training programs for our students in collaboration with firms like Emergway academy, NIT – T COE, Festo India, Kriatek pvt. Ltd. were also conducted.

Extracurricular Activities:

• We believe that our students must get an all-round education as engineering graduates to become responsible members of the society that they will become a part of. As an institution, we encourage the students to participate in various inter-collegiate events where they can exhibit and imbibe extra-curricular education.
