Extension Activities

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The NSS unit of the college is a 100 member strong student team, functioning as a voluntary organisation in the institution. Besides fulfilling requirements under Personality / Character Development Program of Anna University Regulations, activities like Career Guidance Programs, General Medical Check up Camps, Blood Donation Camps, Tree plantation etc. are periodically conducted throughout the year. The NSS volunteers focus more on improving the standard of living of the under privileged and in making them self sustainable. One of the significant activities is a five day village adoption camp taken up every year, where veterinary camps, cleaning of school and temple premises are carried out in the adopted village. The unit actively participates in disaster relief by collecting and disbursing basic provisions. Swachtha Pakhwara is a mass cleaning programme observed as a fortnightly activity throughout the year. Activities like passport Seva camps and traffic regulations awareness are also offered under this scheme.

YOUTH RED CROSS (YRC) Unit of the institution actively plays a role in sensitizing the sensitizing towards social responsibility. In commemoration of Swami Vivekananda's Birth Anniversary Swach Bharat Abhiyan, Campus cleaning programmes are conducted. Awareness programmes on measures to control incidence of Dengue fever, promotion of rain water harvesting methods, campaign against plastic usage etc. have been conducted by this unit. The YRC Unit of the institution has the distinction of receiving the Best YRC Unit and institution award in 2016.

RED RIBBON CLUB (RRC) is another socially active unit of the institution which involves itself actively in blood donation camps, is associated with several blood banks,. identifies and adds new donors to the society. The student donors continue to actively donate blood even after leaving the institution. RRC Free health check-up camps are also conducted for students. AIDS awareness and orientation program "Celebrating life" sponsored by NACO, Tamil Nadu was organized by RRC to ensure zero discrimination, zero infection and zero infected death.

ECO CLUB

The ECO club of the institution entrusts the staff and students with the primary responsibility of planting tree saplings to transform the campus into a green shield. Aggressive tree plantation initiatives are undertaken Slogans like- "Go Green" & "Let us be logical and let us be ecological", are displayed on college buses to campaign for eco awareness. Infosys alumni have extended have planted aound 50 saplings, besides installing a drip irrigation system to ensure adequate watering of planted saplings. The club has initiated the use of wooden waste bins to collect biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes separately for better solid waste management.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT CELL

This cell focuses on strengthening the physical and psychological attributes of women through various empowerment initiatives. Under its banner, the counseling sessions, selfgrooming and self defense sessions, career guidance and personality development programs are arranged to enrich their employability skills. Besides organizing role plays and street plays on "Women Empowerment and safety", basic software skills are imparted to girl students in neighboring villages. Exhibition cum sale is organized every year to generate funds for a rehabilitation centre for visually challenged women every year. "10K MAMMO RUN" was organized to spread awareness on Breast Cancer through in association with Dr.K.Shantha Breast Cancer Foundation. Women achievers are honoured on International Women's Day. In view of Woman's Day, celebrate "Womania" is celebrated on the 08th March of every year show casing various talents of girl students.

SERVICE TO GOVERNMENT EXAMINATIONS & GENERAL ELECTIONS

The Institution is the one among those identified as a centre for conducting TNPSC-Examinations, UGC-NET (National Eligibility Test) and UGC- NEET Medical Entrance Test since 2012. Beside functioning as a NEET examination centre, the institution has been lauded by the media and public for providing quality amenities to candidates and attendants / parents during NEET examination.The Institution also extends its campus facilities to Boards like TANGEDCO, UPSC, HAPP, Police Constable Recruitment Examination, TNPSC GR-II, CMWSSB and UPSC to conduct recruitment examinations..

The institution has also been identified as a potential campus for securing Electronic voting machines/ ballot boxes and for providing infrastructure for counting votes during State Assembly and Parliament Elections.
