
# Team FLUX - JARVIS Design and Manufacturing of an All Terrain Electric Vehicle for SAE -EBAJA competition



Our Team Jarvis, consisting of a few dynamic students (list below) from our college, was shortlisted for the E-BAJA competition conducted by the Society of Automotive Engineers that was held at Chitkara University, Punjab on 15-07-2017. It was indeed a matter of pride for all of us in our institution that, out of the many institutional teams competing on a nationwide basis, our team secured the 28th place at the country level and the 6th place in Tamil Nadu. The final prototype working model was presented to the jury members by the end of December 2017.



The students have built a highly efficient Electrical All-Terrain Vehicle (E-ATV). They started the process by first building the Roll Cage with the standard material procured. After this set up, some of the components which constitute the major part such as the Suspension, Brake systems, Electrical Kit etc were constructed.


