



- Sanction of the President is also conveyed for the carry forward of Rs. 5/- under the non-recurring grant from the last financial year to the current financial year 2019-20.
- 3. This sanction is subject to the condition that the grantee organization will furnish to the Department of Science & Technology, financial year wise Utilization Certificate (UC) in the proforms prescribed as per GFR 2017 and audited statement of expenditure (SF) along with up to date progress report at the end of each financial year duly reflecting the interest earned/accrued on the grants received under the project. This is also subject to the condition of submission of the final statement of expenditure, utilization certificate and project completion report within one year from the scheduled date of completion of the project.
- 4. The grantee organization will have to enter & uplead the Utilization Certificate in the PFMS portal besides sending it in physical form to this Division. The subsequent/final installment will be released only after confirmation of the acceptance of the UC by the Division and entry of previous Utilization Certificate in the PFMS.
- S. If the grant has been released under capital head through separate sanction order under the same project for purchase of equipment(s), separate SE/UC has to be furnished for the released Capital head grant.
- 6. The grant-in-aid being released is subject to the condition that
- (a) a transparent procurement procedure in line with the Provision of General Financial Rules 2017 will be followed by the institute/Organization under the appropriate rules of the grantee organization while procuring capital assets sanctioned for the above mentioned project and a certificate to this effect will be submitted by the Grantee organization immediately on receipt of the grant.

- 8. (a). DST reserves sole rights on the assets out of grants. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of government grants (except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned in accordance with the procedure laid down in GFR 2017), shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of DST.




