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3.4 Extension Activities

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The NSS unit of the college is a 100 member strong student team, functioning as a voluntary organisation in the institution. Besides fulfilling requirements under Personality / Character Development Program of Anna University Regulations, activities like Career Guidance Programs, General Medical Check up Camps, Blood Donation Camps, Tree plantation etc. are periodically conducted throughout the year. The NSS volunteers focus more on improving the standard of living of the under privileged and in making them self sustainable. One of the significant activities is a five day village adoption camp taken up every year, where veterinary camps, cleaning of school and temple premises are carried out in the adopted village. The unit actively participates in disaster relief by collecting and disbursing basic provisions. Swachtha Pakhwara is a mass cleaning programme observed as a fortnightly activity throughout the year. Activities like passport Seva camps and traffic regulations awareness are also offered under this scheme.

The participants were given training in dealing with the situations like Respiratory emergencies, Drowning, wounds, bleeding, Shock, unconsciousness, fractures, Dislocation, Strain and Sprain, burn of the body, poison, snake bites, eye, ear and nose injury, choking, and head injuries with appropriate demonstrations. He also gave a detailed demonstration on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) or heart lung resuscitation is a combined effort to maintain circulation and breathing. At the end of the programme the participants will be in a position to manage an incident, dealing with bleeding and shock, managing an unresponsive casualty, managing a non – breathing casualty, dealing with a choking casualty.

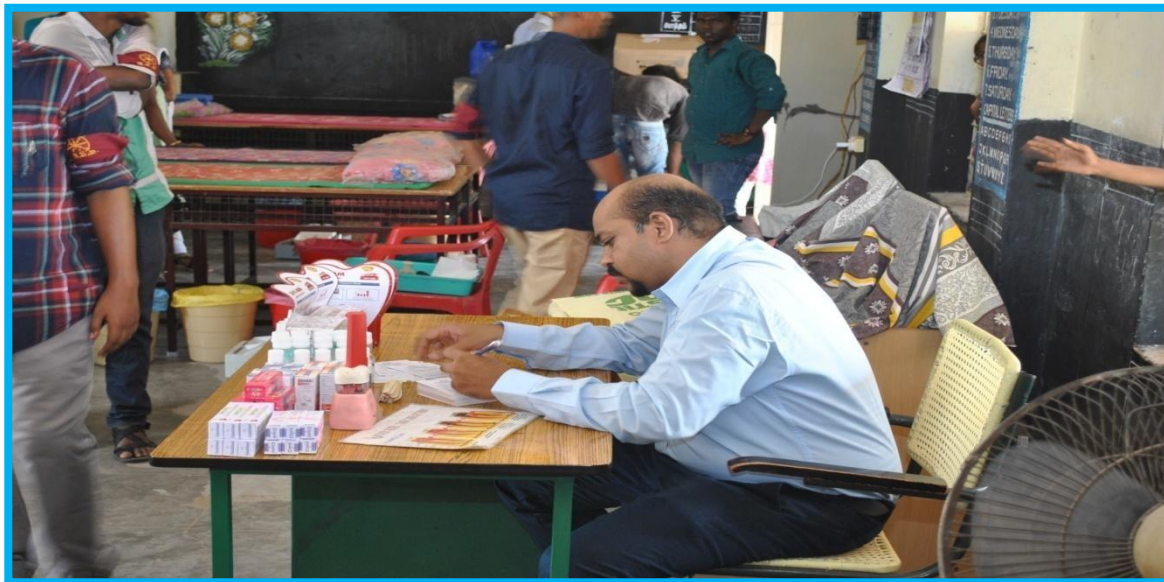

Spread over 10 acres, this minor irrigation tank was re-silted recently by the college with the help of locals and student volunteers.

The college is perhaps the first in the district to be recognised with an appreciation certificate from the district administration and will set an example for others, said district collector S Sivarasa.

The college took up desilting works on water bodies in its surrounding area in July this year.

Infosys alumni have extended have planted around 50 saplings, besides installing a drip irrigation system to ensure adequate watering of planted saplings. The club has initiated the use of wooden waste bins to collect biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes separately for better solid waste management.

ECO CLUB - REPORT

Infosys, Eco club have planned to do one day-tree Plantation Programme(Maximum 50 Plants) in our college before the end of July 2016(on any working Saturday).

In order to undertake the Programme in a systematic way, it was required to create an Eco club in our college as it could play an important role in creating environmental awareness amongst the future generation. (Motto of the ECO club). It is a wonderful opportunity to create awareness, build attitudes, and help the students to take up activities. Interested faculty members in forming the Eco club were requested to contact Ms. M. Padmapriya/Dept of IT.

The tree planting function was scheduled on 23rd July. As per the directions given by the Principal, It had been proposed to inaugurate the ECO club by 11.00 am at MBA Seminar hall on 23/07/2016. Plantation of saplings were also be held immediately after the inaugural function. Dr.V.Mohan Associate Professor/ Dept of ECE & Mr.M.Sridaran /Asst Professor/ Dept of Mech were nominated as ECO club Coordinators.

With the help of Physical Director, Campus In- charge Mr. Vijayan, Locations for planting the saplings were identified. The Plants (Pungai and Vaagai) were obtained from the Horticulture and Isha Nursery, Trichy. Alumni of our college came out with an idea of setting up Drip Irrigation System for watering the plants and Trees for which they contributed Rs.25,000/-. We received quotations from Navamani Electricals and GJ Traders. It is found that the lowest quote was given by Navamani Electricals Trichy. The total Amount for purchasing the equipments, accessories, transportation charges and labor charges was Rs. 31,000/- (Rupees Thirty one thousand Only). This includes 5% of VAT. The Principal is requested to accord the approval for purchasing the Drip Irrigation Materials from Navamani Electricals.



Drip Irrigation system has been successfully erected by Mr. Manoharan from Perumbalur. It was inaugurated on 15-08-2016 as part of our 70th Independence Day celebrations. Alumni of our College (4 members including Rajakumaran and Nataraj) attended the inauguration and dedicated the system to our college. It has been decided to allocate a specific area for a department. It is understood that the saplings within that area will be under the custody of a particular department. For monitoring the growth of the plant and watering the staff-coordinators can allocate one second year, one third year and one final year student per plant. Contribution from Alumni for setting up the Drip Irrigation System at our College Campus. The team led by Rajakumaran, Infosys, Chennai have contributed a Sum of Rs. 25,000/- Towards setting up the drip irrigation system.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT CELL
