



**On December 22, 2017** 

NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY

As a part of celebrating the National Mathematics day on December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017, the department of mathematics, Saranathan college of Engineering, Trichy organized a Guest Lecture. The lecture was delivered by Dr. C. Durairajan, Department of Mathematics, Bharathidasan University, Trichy. Before the event started the HOD welcomed the gathering. Dean of H & S gave the presidential address. He pointed out that Srinivasa Ramanujan is one among the three greatest mathematicians. The unsolved problem of Fermat was solved in 1994 by Hecay using the conjucture of Ramanujan. After the development of computers, Number Theory finds its applications in data theory, coding theory, cryptography etc. He then introduced the distinguished chief guest Dr. C. Durairajan, who had the schooling in Kumbakonam, from where Srinivasa Ramanujan had. The chief guest has published his research papers in International Journals. The radius parameter in coding theory was introduced by Dr. C. Durairajan and he has excelled in this work. Then the session was handed over to the chief guest who quoted the research works of Ramanuja and shared the interested schooling life of the latter. Once when the teacher asked if there are 10 persons and 10 bananas, it can be shared as (10/10=) 1 for each, immediately Ramanuja raised a question if there are 0 bananas and 0 persons, will it be shared as (0/0=) 1 for each which is contradictory. Hence Srinivasa Ramanujan is not wrong in being considered as the greatest Indian mathematician. He then elaborated the work of



mathematics in coding theory to the students and staff. The celebration came to a conclusion with the valedictory function in which Prof. D. Geetha delivered the vote of thanks.


