



## Smart India Hackathon -2022 – A Report

In the SIH 2022, out of 99 total teams registered for Internal Hackathon, the best teams were selected for participating in the internal hackathon through an internal review conducted with our panel of internal expert members. 44 teams were short listed from the internal review to participate in the Internal Hackathon. The Internal hackathon was conducted with the external subject experts in online mode. Out of 44 teams, 30 teams were shortlisted for uploading their ideas in the SIH website.

In the pre-screening conducted by Overall SIH technical experts, six teams were shortlisted for participating in the SIH Grand Finale. Five teams were selected under software category and one team was selected under hardware category to exhibit their proposed models in the grand finale conducted at various nodal centers such as Bangalore, Ernakulam, Salem, Ahmedabad and Kanpur.

Our college team NEOSPARKERS participated in Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2022 Grand Finale held between 25-08-22 and 29-08-22 at R V University, Bangalore has been adjudged as Winners of SIH -2022 (hardware stream). The team proposed a model for the Problem statement on finding a "Solution to Detect Air Quality inside the Cabin and Improve it", posted by Volvo and won the title award. The team shares the title award with SRM Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai.

They received a cash award of Rs.50,000/-. In addition to it, our management is magnanimous to award the winners with the additional cash award of Rs. 50,000/- (equivalent to the cash award which they won in SIH-2022).

In order to appreciate the efforts taken by the mentor, an appreciation along with the cash award of Rs.5000/- was given to the faculty mentor Mr. G. Sivakannu, Asst. Professor, Department of ECE. The SPoC of SIH Dr.P.Shanmugapriya, Associate Professor, Dept of ECE has also been appreciated with a cash award of Rs. 5000/-.
